A NOTE FROM THE FINANCE COUNCIL

At the start of our current fiscal year, the finance council established an overall operating budget of \$239,000.

This is inclusive of all income and expenditures required to operate the parish. Since we only publish the regular weekly offering, we are adjusting our Operational Budget Needs to \$214,000, which includes only the regular weekly offering.


This will help us more accurately track and publish how we are doing with our regular weekly offering versus parish needs.
